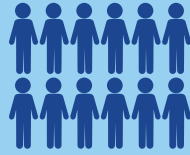

FROM THE DIRECTOR

Thanks to the dedication of our staff and the support of our community, 2025 was a year of meaningful progress across all ten branches of the Clermont County Public Library as we continued to fulfill our mission to inform, engage, and inspire.

Throughout the year, we focused on strengthening access to library resources and increasing community engagement. The launch of a redesigned website and enhanced catalog made it easier for residents to discover and use our collections and services. A targeted marketing campaign delivered through streaming television platforms increased community awareness of the Library's free resources and contributed to growth in library card signups.

Community connection remained central to our work. From the addition of a reading-themed mural at the Williamsburg Branch in celebration of America250 to the launch of our first Community Reading Challenge, we created opportunities for residents to participate in shared experiences centered on literacy. The response was extraordinary. Our community surpassed the 8 million-minute goal with more than 10 million minutes read.

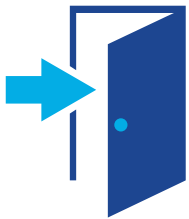
Together, these efforts reflect a library system that continues to evolve, respond, and provide meaningful opportunities for lifelong learning throughout Clermont County.

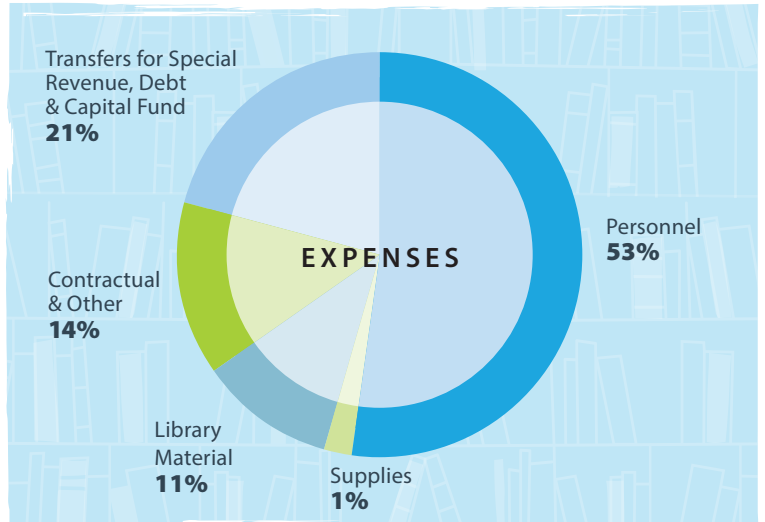
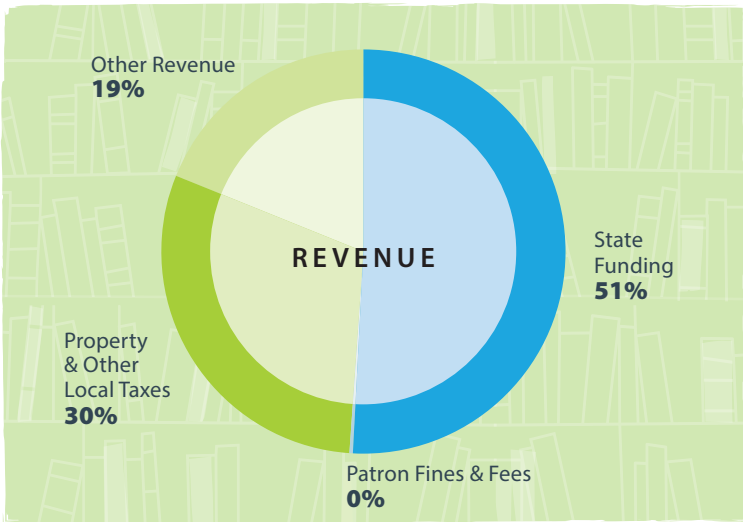
